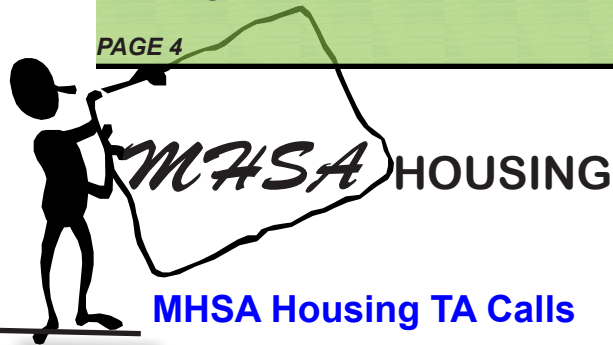

**3rd** Wednesday MHSA Housing Program for Small Counties Focusing on the unique needs of Small Counties.

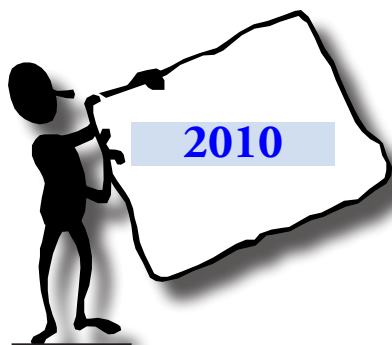

## TCP TRAINING

The Transformational Care Planning Training is a two-day clinical training geared towards helping Children and Adult System of Care Mental Health Practitioners and Administrators (Therapists, Case Managers, Psychiatrists, QI managers) develop skills in creating person-centered treatment plans that reflect the values of recovery, wellness, resiliency, and family-directed care, while maintaining compliance with Medi-Cal and statutory regulation.
