NATURE OF PROCEEDINGS – ORDER ALLOWING INTERAGENCY  
INFORMATION EXCHANGE

Pursuant to Welfare and Institutions Code sections 827 and 828 and California Rules of Court, Rule 1423, the Court hereby makes the following order:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that juvenile court records, as defined in Rule 1423, may be inspected, copied or obtained, without further authorization from the Court, by court personnel, the district attorney, the minor who is the subject of the proceedings, his or her parents or guardian, the attorneys for the parties, judges, referees, hearing officers, probation officers, law enforcement officers who are actively participating in criminal or juvenile proceedings involving the minor, the superintendent or designee of the school district where the minor is enrolled or attending school, members of the child protective agencies as defined in Section 11165.9 of the Penal Code, members of children’s multidisciplinary teams, and persons or agencies providing treatment or supervision of the minor.

Any records or reports, or any portion(s) thereof, shall not be disseminated by the receiving agencies to any persons or agencies, other than those persons or agencies authorized to receive documents pursuant to this order.
