SUBJECT: Distribution for Early and Periodic Screening, Diagnosis and Treatment
(EPSDT) State Funding for Fiscal Year (FY) 2005-06

This letter and its attachments describe the Department of Mental Health (DMH) payment procedures and the Mental Health Plan (MHP) matching fund obligations for FY 2005-06 for EPSDT specialty mental health services.

Payment Procedures and MHP Matching Fund Obligations

DMH will make a monthly distribution of 95 percent of the state general funds (SGFs) for EPSDT based on Short-Doyle/Medi-Cal (SD/MC) approved claims data for the MHP of the beneficiary. EPSDT SGFs payments will be finalized as a part of the cost settlement process. MHPs are responsible for providing the matching funds for the EPSDT baseline and the 10 percent match on the growth in the total state match above the FY 2001-02 level.

DMH developed this distribution process beginning in FY 2003-04 to: 1) provide a distribution methodology that accommodates county accounting procedures for handling expected revenues (e.g., some counties are not permitted to budget revenue that will not be paid within one year of the date of service), 2) improve the accuracy of payments, since payments will be based on approved claims and 3) increase the percent of expected payments distributed to MHPs from 75 percent to 95 percent based on the anticipated increase in the accuracy of payments.

The monthly distribution amount will adjust each MHP's EPSDT claims for dates of service in FY 2005-06 for the federal/state sharing ratio, the EPSDT baseline, the expected 10 percent matching requirement, and then reduce the balance by five percent to bring payments to 95 percent of expected reimbursement. DMH expects to issue payments within 60 days of the date the claims are approved, allowing up to 30 days for DMH to calculate the funds due and up to 30 days for the State Controller's Office to issue payment, beginning with the approved claims with dates of service on or after July 1, 2005. Distributions for FY 2004-05 EPSDT approved claims will continue during FY 2005-06 and will be tracked separately to ensure appropriate cost settlement.

**DETAILED DESCRIPTION OF EARLY AND PERIODIC SCREENING,
DIAGNOSIS AND TREATMENT (EPSDT) MONTHLY DISTRIBUTION
PROCESS FOR FISCAL YEAR (FY) 2005-06**

Beginning with FY 2003-04 DMH discontinued the distribution of state funds for EPSDT specialty mental health services to Mental Health Plans (MHPs) through an annualized initial payment. DMH now distributes these state general funds (SGFs) monthly based on monthly Short-Doyle/Medi-Cal (SD/MC) approved claims data for the MHP of the beneficiaries. The monthly distribution amount will be calculated for FY 2005-06 as follows:

1. Claims for dates of service in FY 2005-06 approved during each calendar month will be identified by DMH.
2. DMH will adjust the approved claims amounts as follows (adjustment percentages are provided by MHP in Attachment 2):
 - a. a reduction for the state/federal sharing ratio for the year (the EPSDT approved claims total will be multiplied by the state share for FY 2005-06 of 50 percent)
 - b. a reduction for the MHP's SD/MC and Phase II baseline obligations that will be calculated by dividing the MHP's baseline amount by the DMH estimate of the expected cost-settled total EPSDT claims for the MHP for FY 2005-06 (the result from a. will be multiplied by the difference between 100 percent and the calculated reduction)
 - c. a reduction for the MHP's 10 percent county matching requirement on growth above the MHP's FY 2001-02 EPSDT costs that will be calculated by dividing the DMH estimate of the expected matching amount by the DMH estimate of the expected total state matching requirement for EPSDT claims for the MHP for FY 2005-06 (the result from b. will be multiplied by the difference between 100 percent and the calculated reduction)
 - d. a reduction of five percent, which is the standard deduction DMH makes on most monthly allocation payments to county mental health departments (the result from c. will be multiplied by 95 percent)

A sample calculation is provided as Attachment 3.

DMH expects to issue payments within 60 days of the date the claims are approved, allowing up to 30 days for DMH to calculate the funds due and up to 30 days for the State Controller's Office to issue payment.

MHP Reconciliation of Amounts Paid

DMH will provide MHPs, via e-mail to the mental health director, with a monthly summary showing the approved EPSDT claims amount and final EPSDT SGF distribution amount for the month by MHP of beneficiary and the approved claims total after each of the adjustments described above. MHPs that want to reconcile at the actual approved claim level may access the claims information through Information Technology Web Services (ITWS) on the DMH website by reviewing the County of Fiscal Responsibility files.

Baseline Requirements

MHPs remain responsible for non-federal portion of the SD/MC and Phase II baseline. The baseline for FY 2005-06 is provided as Attachment 4.

County Matching Requirement on Growth

MHPs also remain responsible for the county match requirement that is 10 percent of the growth of the state/local match above the FY 2001-02 cost settled amounts. Attachment 5 displays the FY 2001-02 cost settled EPSDT services by county of beneficiary, the estimated growth of cost settled amounts between FY 2001-02 and FY 2005-06 and the estimated county funding required to meet the 10 percent matching requirement. This 10 percent county match requirement is in addition to the county match for the baseline.

The county match requirement may be met using any source of funds allowed for match in the Short-Doyle/Medi-Cal program. The MHP certifies on each Medi-Cal claim submitted that there are sufficient funds available to match the federal funds. The MHP's match requirements include the baseline and ten percent of the state share of growth in FY 2005-06.

Adjustments to the Percentage Adjustments

DMH will consider requests from MHPs for adjustments to the percentage adjustments for monthly distributions based on documentation from the MHP that the MHP's actual experience is different from the DMH estimates being applied to the distributions. Changes to any one factor will be considered in the context of the effect on the other adjustments. For example, a decrease in the baseline adjustment would increase the estimated total dollars, which may increase the percentage adjustment for the 10 percent county match and decrease the baseline adjustment percentage (e.g., if an MHP expected to increase total EPSDT expenditures, the baseline would be a smaller percent of the total, but the 10 percent match on growth would be higher).

OF THE \$150,000 IN CLAIMS, \$50,000 WERE FOR DATES OF SERVICE PRIOR TO JULY 1, 2005, LEAVING \$100,000 IN APPROVED CLAIMS.

OF THE \$100,000 IN APPROVED CLAIMS, \$50,000 WERE FOR SERVICES TO EPSDT ELIGIBLE BENEFICIARIES.

OF THE \$50,000 FOR EPSDT ELIGIBLES, \$5,000 WERE FOR SERVICES FOR EPSDT ELIGIBLES FROM OTHER COUNTIES, LEAVING \$45,000.

DURING THE MONTH OF JULY, SKY COUNTY HAD \$10,000 IN APPROVED CLAIMS FOR EPSDT ELIGIBLES FROM RAINBOW COUNTY.

THE TOTAL EPSDT APPROVED CLAIMS FOR RAINBOW COUNTY FOR JULY WOULD BE \$45,000 FROM RAINBOW COUNTY CLAIMS PLUS \$10,000 FOR SKY COUNTY CLAIMS FOR A TOTAL OF \$55,000.

\$55,000 IS THEN MULTIPLIED BY THE BLENDED STATE SHARING RATIO OF 50.00 PERCENT, WHICH EQUALS \$27,500.

THE \$27,500 IS THEN ADJUSTED FOR RAINBOW COUNTY 'S BASELINE OBLIGATIONS. FOR RAINBOW COUNTY THE ADJUSTMENT IS 82.29 PERCENT. THE ADJUSTED AMOUNT IS \$22,629.21.

THE \$22,629.21 IS THEN ADJUSTED FOR RAINBOW COUNTY 'S TEN PERCENT MATCH ON GROWTH. FOR RAINBOW COUNTY THE ADJUSTMENT IS 96.31 PERCENT. THE ADJUSTED AMOUNT IS \$21,794.62.

THE \$21,794.62 IS THEN REDUCED BY 5 PERCENT TO ALLOW FOR ERRORS IN THE ADJUSTMENT PROCESS. \$21,794.62 MULTIPLIED BY 95 PERCENT EQUALS \$20,704.89.

RAINBOW COUNTY RECEIVES A DISTRIBUTION OF \$20,704.89 FOR FY 2005-06 EPSDT SERVICES TO RAINBOW COUNTY BENEFICIARIES SUBMITTED BY JULY 31, 2005.
